Because a vital part of our governmental system is policy making through legislative assemblies, Congress was selected as a contest for University Interscholastic League. Congress replicates the workings of an official legislation within the confines of a competitive speech activity. The purpose of Congress is to formulate legislative bills and resolutions, debate them, and adopt or reject them by vesting votes. A congress is divided into chambers. Each chamber has a presiding officer elected by the delegates to call on members to speak and to maintain order and decorum. Also vital to the chamber is the parliamentarian who makes final decisions on matters of parliamentary procedure. Scorers award points to each participant.

Speaking in legislative debate is done within a structured environment of specific procedural rules known as parliamentary law. Competitive student congress mimics real-life legislative assemblies and presents its participants with an insight into the issues and problems and policies that actually confront our lawmakers. Students must not only find data to support or negate a piece of legislation, but also must understand parliamentary rules and the application of those rules within the legislative body.

Congressmen and women must deliver formal discourse on the merit and disadvantages of each

piece of legislation and vote to pass or defeat the measure they have examined. Students extemporaneously respond to others' arguments over the course of a session. They are evaluated for the research and analysis of issues, argumentation, skill in asking and answering questions, use of parliamentary procedure, as well as clarity and fluency of speaking.



Participating in a mock legislative congress teaches students the proper decorum in meetings and promotes critical listening and skilled notetaking. Because students must create laws in order to solve real-world issues, problem-solving skills are demanded. Negotiating arts and medication must occur, emphasizing interpersonal communication as students seek to pass their piece of legislation successfully. Civility in discourse is increased and writing skills become necessary to develop compelling arguments. The result is the increase in citizenship, cultivating a respect for public service and a desire to contribute to society. As a student-driven contest, Congress builds leaders.

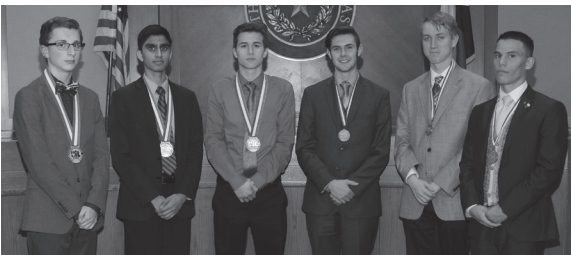

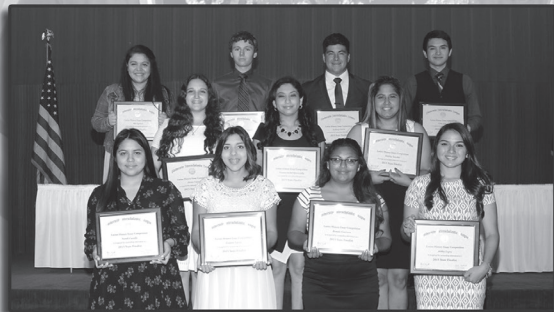

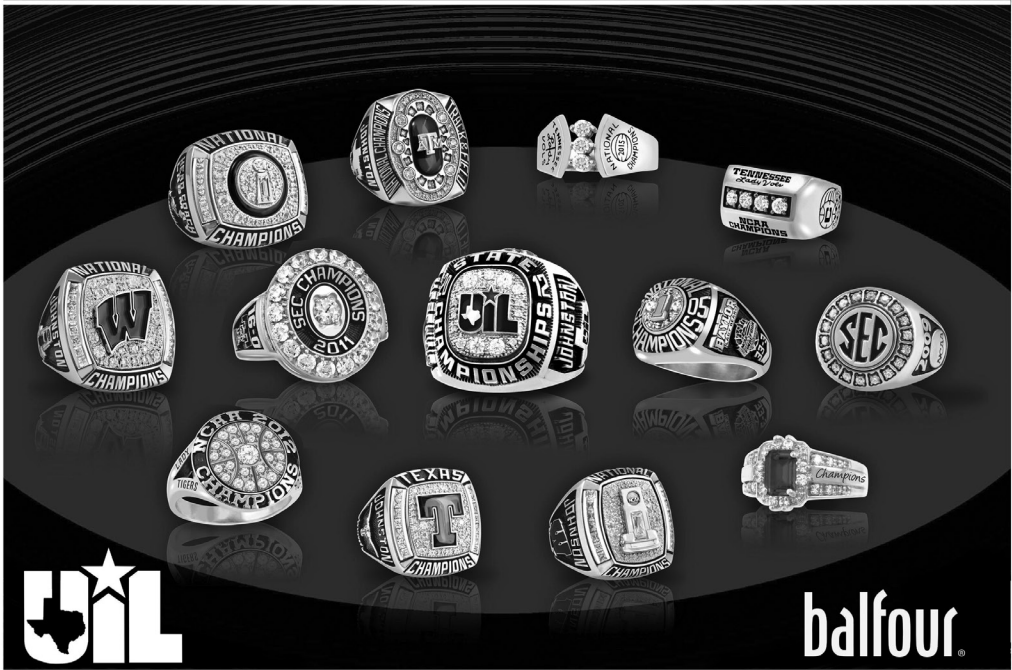

All congress sessions are open to the public. We encourage students, parents and administrators to remain as audience members for the Super Congress championship rounds.



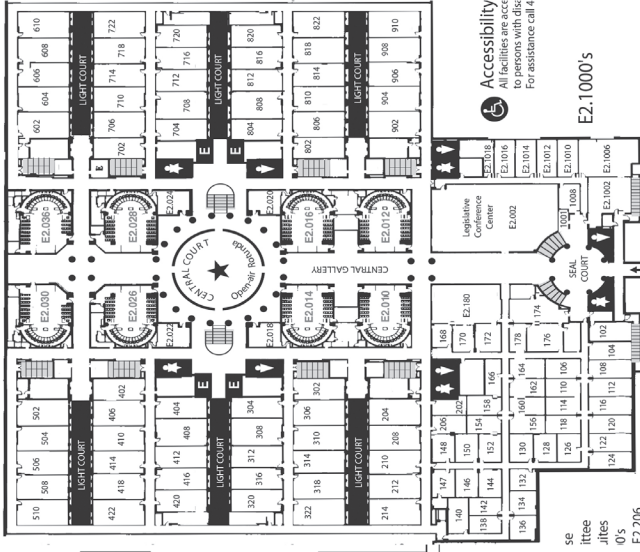


# TEXAS CAPITOL ROOM MAPS

E2.200 through E2.900's

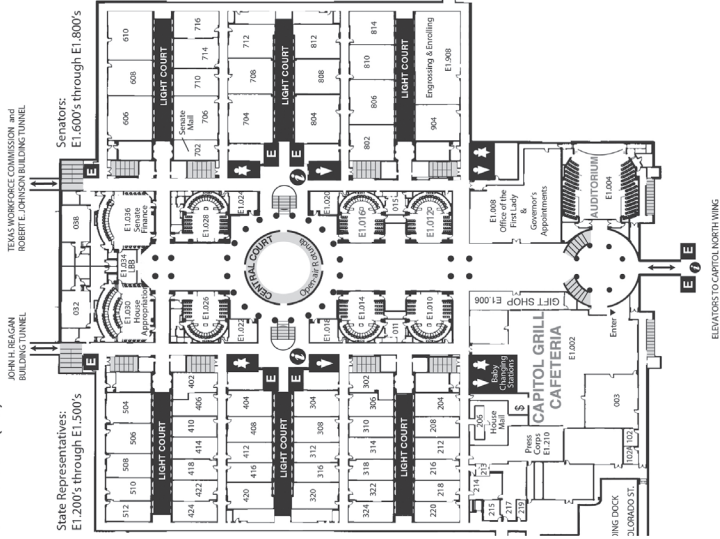

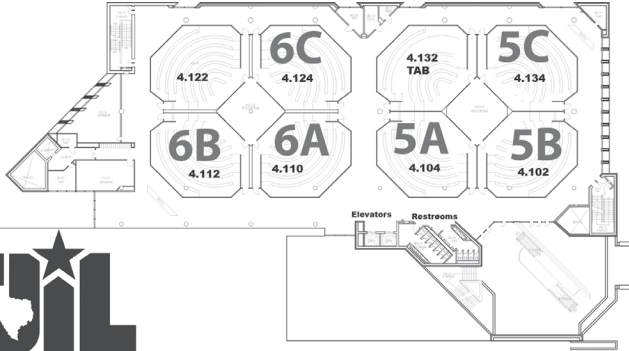

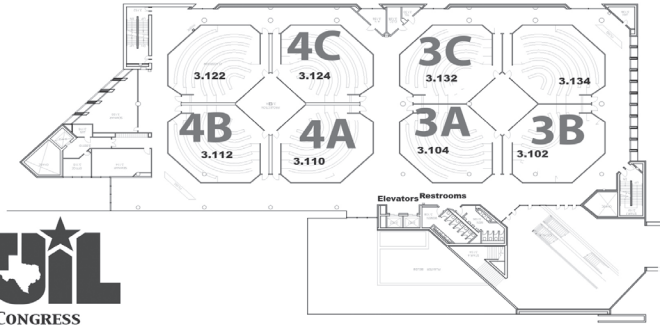

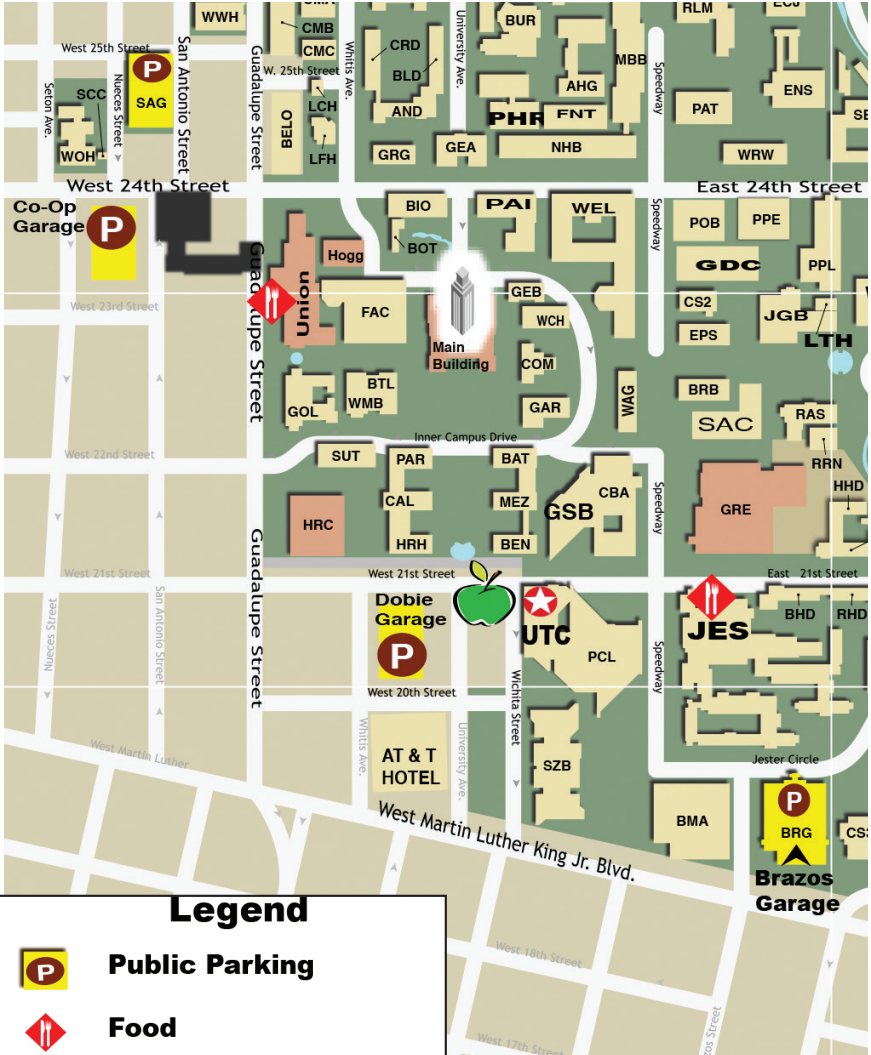
