

UIL Congress State Meet Procedures Region Clerks and Qualifying Schools

Registration and Entry Fees:

Ballots will be electronic. The region meet results submitted by the Region Clerk in **SpeechWire** tournament management system serve as your registration to the State Meet. There are no entry fees to the UIL State Congress Meet.

Region Clerk submits legislation for State Meet.

Submit legislation for each conference qualifying from your ESC Region via email to State Director: jriggins@uiltexas.org

Deadline: November 18, 2024

See the Contest Rules. **Each conference advancing from an ESC Region to State shall submit one bill or resolution and an alternate piece, should it be needed, to be considered for legislation in their conference chamber. ESC officials may **not** submit legislation borrowed from another region. Legislation may come from the region docket or be new original legislation written by the state-qualifying students.*

You do **NOT** need to ask your judges to create their own SpeechWire judge accounts. **Judges should NOT create their own accounts on SpeechWire!** As we (UIL) register them, if they don't already have an account, one will automatically be created for them and they will be emailed login details to use to judge the tournament.
