Journalism Tips

Carol Cox, Archer City High School

News Writing

- O Leads are key
- Look for future event
- O If no future event, lead with what students don't already know
- O Leads should be 1-2 sentences
- First quote should be from authority in the story
- O Use transition/quote formula
- Make sure to include student quote
- Story should be balanced

Feature Writing

- Lead needs to grab reader's attention and appeal to emotions
- Lead can be longer than one paragraph
- Make sure lead flows into first quote which should be from the person the story is about
- News peg needs to be used early in story
- Use transition/quote formula
- O Focus on flow
- Vary transitions
- End with strong quote or tie back to beginning of story

Editorial Writing

- Lead is similar to summary news lead (1-2 sentences)
- Stance is a separate paragraph (1 sentence)
- Need 2 or 3 reasons to support stance (3-4 sentence paragraph for each)
- Include rebuttal paragraph (2-3 sentences)
- Concluding paragraph includes restatement of stance and call to action (2-3 sentences)
- No quotes or rhetorical questions

Headline Writing

- Make sure fits count
- Should read like a sentence with subject and verb (unless main head)
- O Use active voice
- O Give as much information as possible
- O Avoid splits
- O Watch spelling

Copy Editing

- Tab A.P. Stylebook (new version this year)
- Point values for Part 2 have doubled (weighted more)
- O Make sure to complete something on Part 3
- Practice, practice, practice
- Purchase A.P. Stylebook Study Guides
