- Autonomy Encourages Personal Growth



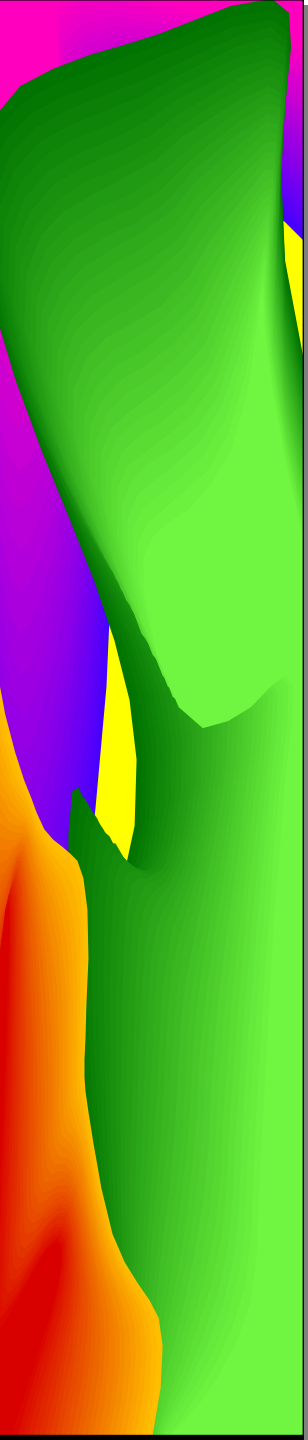



- *Instead Encourage Goals such as:

- + Finding Better Understanding
of Character

- +Finding the Social Significance
in a Piece

- *Push Students Toward Self-Discovery &
Understanding of their Literature or
Speech Topic or Argument



Going Digital

- Record Performances and have Students Critique Themselves
- Recordings can be done to Focus on
 - *Physicality
 - *Characterization
 - *Vocal Emphasis and Variety
 - *Etc.
- Allow Students to Point Out their Own Problems
