

CURRENT YEAR YEARBOOK Contest Rules

- Submit entries from the 2025 school yearbook. Deadline for entries is March 1, 2025 All work must be that of the student(s) named and set to be published in the 2025 yearbook. All submissions must be submitted through the online uploading system.
- All entries become the property of ILPC and may be published in ILPC or UIL materials.
- Depending on the number of entries, we may split schools into combined conferences. Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to first, second and third place, respectively. Results will be announced at the ILPC State Convention. No Tops in Texas will be awarded for this contest.
- Work submitted in this contest is not eligible for the following year's Yearbook IAA contest.

Decisions of the judges are final.

Current Year YB Individual Achievement Awards Categories

To participate in this category, you must submit (through the uploading system) completed yearbook pdfs (or jpegs for photos) with all photos, captions, copy and graphics included. All submissions are due March 1.

Submit one (1) entry in each of the following categories. Once submitted, this entry cannot be resubmitted the following year in the regular IAA Yearbook categories.

1. **FEATURE SPREAD** – This spread may come from any section and should feature people and action. You may not submit this spread in any other category.
2. **STUDENT LIFE-FOCUSED SPREAD** – The dominant package on this spread should emphasize student activities and events outside the classroom.
3. **SPORTS-FOCUSED SPREAD** – The dominant package on this spread should emphasize a sport or sports team.
4. **ACADEMIC-FOCUSED SPREAD** – The dominant package on this spread should emphasize academic events or activities.
5. **PEOPLE SECTION SPREAD** – This spread should show a portion of your portraits along with secondary coverage.
6. **CLUB/ORGANIZATION-FOCUSED SPREAD** – The dominant package on this spread should emphasize club/organization activities and events.
7. **BLENDED COVERAGE SPREAD** – This spread can cover from any section of the book and should cover at least two different topics.
8. **STORY** – A story from any section of the yearbook.
9. **PHOTO PORTFOLIOS – FOR SENIORS ONLY. TWO ENTRIES ALLOWED.** Three photos (that will be published in the yearbook) shot by one individual. You can include caption information in metadata.
