#### Corv Broom. 7916 Hook Dr., Plano, Tx. 75025.

Has been involved with UIL One Act Play for the past 20 years, as student, director and now adjudicator. He believes whole-heartedly in the educational value of this unique experience for students. He holds a BFA in Theatre from Texas State University and a Master's in Education from Lamar University. As a UIL One Act Play director, his productions appeared at the State meet three times and placed as the 6A State Second Runner Up in 2017. Cory's students also advanced to the State Finals numerous times in UIL Oral Interpretation events. He was honored to be named as Campus Teacher of the Year for the 2014-15 school year at Little Cypress-Mauriceville High School and received the award of Southeast Texas Fine Arts Educator of the Year in 2014 by the Southeast Texas Arts Council. As an adjudicator, Cory has been a respondent for schools in conferences 1A-6A from Zone to the Regional level. He now works with students in a rigorous Collegiate Academy program, partnering with Collin College, where students

Honors include being named McLennan Community College Outstanding Alumnus - 2013; TxETA Founder's Award – 2009; Amegy Bank/Baytown Sun Teaching Excellence Award - 2006 and UIL Sponsor Excellence Award - 2002. Poe, based in Central Texas (Waco area), is a TTAO certified contest manager and adjudicator in addition to serving as a clinician.

Is a graduate of Texas Woman's University and holds a M.A. and B.A. in Theatre. She taught middle school and high school theatre for sixteen years with UIL OAP District, Bi-District, Area and Regional appearances. She is an Actor's Equity Membership Candidate. In 2015, she was awarded the Texas Educational Theatre Associations K-8 Educator of the Year and was also named the 2015-2016 Rockwall ISD Cain Middle School Teacher of the Year. She is an Honorary Lifetime PTA Member and a member of the Collin Theatre Center Hall of Fame. Ms. Glanton currently serves as the Fine Arts Coordinator in Forney ISD, overseeing the Dance, Cheer and Theatre programs. She is a strong supporter of Texas educational theatre and has served the TxETA Board of Directors as K-12 Chair, and Texas Thespians as Junior Festival Chair. She currently serves on the Texas Thespians Executive Board, Director of the Texas Thespians Advocacy Network and TTAO as Region II Adjudicator Rep on the Standards and Practices Committee. In 2021, she was awarded the Texas Thespians Trailblazer Award for her contributions to educational theatre. Ms. Glanton is a product of the UIL One-Act Competition and continues to value its process, purpose and benefits to students across the state.

Please make sure to read your OAP Handbook. If you fail to bring any of the necessary paperwork you will not be able to perform. All documentation must be presented prior to the start of your scheduled rehearsal.

## **Unloading**

Schools will unload equipment/scenery at the loading dock door.

Companies are welcome to unload all scenery and costumes 30 minutes prior to the scheduled rehearsal time (as indicated on schedule). Upon arrival you will be greeted by contest personnel. On-site personnel will be there to assist with directives.

#### Rehearsal

Each group will have one hour to rehearse. *Groups will need to completely strike the stage by the end of the official rehearsal time.* 

Please be on time. Events will run as scheduled.

#### Strike/ Loadout

Following your performance, each company will strike out to the dock and load out. If there is inclement weather, adjustments will be made. Following load-out, you will be escorted back to your dressing room.

Please use the parking lot adjacent to the Lion Center for all buses and trucks and for visitor parking during the contest.

# **Dressing Rooms**

Each company will be assigned an area in the gym during the duration of the competition. Please remember the dressing rooms are locker rooms in the gym and do not contain mirrors: therefore, you will need to provide your own. As a courtesy to the host school, please leave your preparation area as you as clean as you found them. Companies should strike all materials from gym area/locker rooms prior to

the Awards Ceremony. Please leave the space as clean as you found it.
