Substitutions The District Tournament Director will notify the Regional Director of any scratches or substitutions after they have notified and confirmed attendance of the alternate. Alternates will be weighed in with other competitors and must be present to be considered for entry in the tournament. Once weigh-ins for a particular weight class have concluded, there will be no substitutions.

Bags Austin ISD has instituted a clear bag policy at all central facilities for spectators. No bags larger

> than 12 x 12 will be permitted in Delco Activity Center. The only non-clear bags permitted are small clutch bags that are the size of a hand. Camera bags and purses are also subject to these guidelines. Exceptions will be made for medically necessary items after proper inspection.

Packets Coaches packets can be picked up at Delco Activity Center on Thursday, February 6th from

4:30pm-6:30pm or on Friday, February 7th from 7:00am-7:30am. The wrestling mats will be

available for warm-up on Thursday.

Passes

Participating school's principals and athletic directors will be granted tournament admittance with proper identification. COACHES NAMES must be submitted to Denise Vanlandingham at denise.vanlandingham@austinisd.org by Wednesday, February 5th for issuance of all access badge. Floor access will not be granted to anyone except coaches whose names are submitted.

Concessions

Concession stands will be available for the duration of the tournament. No outside food or drinks are allowed. This includes refillable water containers. Team items must be brought in through the team entrance. Hospitality will be provided for coaches and staff.

Programs

Programs will be sold during the tournament for \$3.00.

Video Policy

Video cameras will be allowed under UIL rules. Cameras must not interfere with the spectators' opportunity to view the matches. Spectators must remain upstairs and will not be allowed to stand at the railings during the matches.

Awards

The top six places will be scored according to the National Federation rulebook. The top six places will receive individual medals. Team championship plaques will be presented as well as outstanding male and female wrestler and Regional Coaches of the Year.

Warm-Up

Wrestlers will warm-up in the designated area. Bout numbers will be posted on screens placed throughout the facility. No wrestlers or coaches will be allowed in the mat area until time for their match. Athletes and spectators will not observe matches from the floor.

Wrestle Back *NEW* Wrestle backs are allowed for advancement purposes, and the match is considered to be part of the tournament. The wrestle back match will happen only if the 4th place finisher has not defeated the 5th place finisher in the tournament. The winner of the 4th place wrestle back match will be considered the 4th place finisher and qualifier for the subsequent tournament. The loser of the 4th place wrestle back match will be considered the 5th place finisher and the alternate for the subsequent tournament. Placement points earned for finishing 4th and 5th will be applied to the winner of the match accordingly. There are no advancement points nor bonus points for the true 4th challenge matches.

Alternates

Alternates shall be weighed in with the other competitors. Alternates will be placed in the bracket if the advancing wrestler is unable to attend. An advancing wrestler unable to compete due to injury, not making weight, or not being present at the start of weigh-ins can only be replaced from the alternates from his/her same qualifying tournament. Alternates are to be placed in the 4th qualifying position, moving other seeded wrestlers up one spot.

Dressing Room There will be no dressing room facilities available at Delco for changing or showering.

Hotels

The UIL has compiled a listing of Austin Area hotels offering a discounted UIL rate. These hotels are on a first come first serve basis and all hotels may not have rooms available at the listed rate. Hotels listed in the North and Northwest grouping are those closest to Delco Activity Center. The Sleep inn is the closest hotel to Delco.

Seeding

The bracket type being used in the regional tournaments is 16 Man WB-3rd True-4th Place 6. The same 12 bracket variations used for the UIL State Wrestling Tournament will be utilized for the 6A Region 4 Tournament. The district champions will be placed in order on lines 1, 16, 9, and 8 using separation criteria of state placement and regional placement. Any district champion not meeting the criteria above will be randomly drawn for the remaining of the four lines. Seeding and bracket draws will take place once all district tournaments have concluded.
