Alternates will be weighed in with other competitors and must be present to be considered for entry in the tournament. Once weigh-ins for a particular weight class have concluded, there will be no substitutions.

Bags:	Corpus Christi ISD has instituted a clear bag policy at all facilities for spectators. The non-clear bags permitted are small clutch bags 4.5"x6.5", about the size of a hand. C bags and purses are also subject to these guidelines. Exceptions will be made for me necessary items after proper inspection.		

Packets & Pratice:	Coaches' packets can be picked up in the Arena at Mary Carroll High School on Thursday, February 6 th from 4:30pm-6:30pm or on Friday, February 7 th from 7:00am-7:30am. The mats will be available for use on the 6th, as soon as they are set up, which we hope to have complete at 4:30 PM, but it may take longer. The gym will be cleared at 6:30 PM	
Passes:	Participating schools' principals and athletic directors will be granted tournament admittance with proper identification. COACHES NAMES must be submitted to Michael Keel at michael.keel@ccisd.us by Wednesday, February 6 th Floor access will not be granted to anyone except coaches whose names are submitted. No non-school employee/ club coaches are ever allowed on the floor, or in the corner of a match. If caught they will be escorted out, and the school that they were coaching will be turned into the UIL.	
Concessions:	Concession stands will be available during the duration of the tournament. No outside food or drinks are allowed. Team items must be brought in through the team entrance. Hospitality will be provided for coaches and staff, breakfast and lunch-both days.	
Video Policy:	Video cameras will be allowed under UIL rules. Cameras must not interfere with the spectators' opportunity to watch the matches. Spectators must remain in designated areas and will not be allowed to stand at the railings during the matches.	
Awards:	The top six places will be scored according to the National Federation rulebook. The top four places will receive individual medals. Team championship plaques will be presented as well as outstanding male and female wrestler and Regional Coaches of the Year. Have athletes in proper school attire.	
Warm-Up:	Wrestlers will warm-up in the designated area. Bout numbers will be posted on screens placed throughout the facility. No wrestlers or coaches will be allowed in the mat area until time for their match. Athletes and spectators will not observe matches from the floor.	
Wrestle Back:	Wrestle backs are allowed for advancement purposes, and the match is considered to be part of the tournament. The winner of the 4th place wrestle back match will be considered the 4th place finisher and qualifier for the subsequent tournament. The loser of the 4th place wrestle back match will be considered the 5th place finisher and the alternate for the subsequent tournament. Placement points earned for 5 finishing 4th and 5th will be applied to the winner of the match accordingly. There are no advancement points nor bonus points for true 4th challenge matches.	
Dressing Room:	There will be no dressing room facilities available for changing or showering.	
Seeding:	THERE WILL BE NO SEEDING. The 4 regional qualifiers from each district will automatically be placed into 16 man brackets using pre-defined placements. The same 12 bracket variations used for the UIL State Wrestling Tournament will be utilized for the 5A Region 4 Tournament. The bracket type being used in the regional tournaments is 16 Man WB-3rd True-4th Place 6.	
Bracket:	The bracket assigned to each weight class will be determined by random draw separately for boys and girls. One bracket number will be drawn and assigned to weight class 106 for the boys. Weight class 113 will then be assigned the next bracket in order. Once bracket #12 has been assigned to a weight class, the next weight class will start over with bracket #1. For boys, two brackets will be used twice. The girls will follow a similar procedure with a separate draw and two bracket numbers will not be used. The bracket draw will take place once all district tournaments have concluded.
