2025 Region 2 AAA Golf Tournament Oak Hurst Golf Course

FORMAT: 36 holes stroke play. Ties for medalists or ties that affect advancement to the UIL State Golf Tournament will be broken by sudden death playoff if possible. UIL guidelines will determine advancement if not.

TEES: Gentlemen will play from the WHITE tees. Ladies will play from the RED tees.

PENALTY AREAS: Defined by Red lines and stakes. See rule 17.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Defined by white stakes or fences (all fences are out of bounds). See Rule 18.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR:

- a) Any area defined by a white line.
- b) Fire ant mounds that interfere with stance or swing, stumps and
- c) All bunkers will be played as GROUND UNDER REPAIR

PACE OF PLAY: Any group that is out of position with the group in front of them and is averaging more than 15 minutes a hole (a 4½ hour round), will be asked to catch up and informed that they will be timed. A player has 40 seconds (50 seconds to the player that has the honors) in which to make their shot. A warning will be given to any player that is slower than this. Second offense will be a one-stroke penalty: the third offense will be a two-stroke penalty; any subsequent offense may be disqualification. See Rule 6-7. Please play expediently.

USGA rules will govern all play with the exception of the following local rules and UIL rules pertaining to disqualification:

- 1) Drop zones are provided on holes #2, #3,#4, #7, & #16 as an additional option to Rule 17 for any ball entering the Penalty Area beyond the drop zone.
- 2) The maximum score on any hole is a 9, a player shall pick up the ball and record a score of 9 if the 8th stroke is not holed out.
- 3) Golfers are required to carry all clothing needed except that which they can pick up at the end of nine holes at the club house. Spectators, coaches and other players <u>cannot</u> deliver articles of clothing to golfers on course.
- Contestants may not use caddies or electric carts during district, regional or state matches. Pull carts may be used, but participants are required to begin the round with a pull cart if one is desired.
- 5) Players may NOT return to the golf course once your round is complete (except for playoffs. You may congregate around 18 green to watch your teammates finish).

We will make every effort to complete a 36 hole tournament. The tournament will consist of 9-18-27 or 36 holes completed by the entire tournament field from a scoring standpoint.

Cart Path

Spectators: Parents, friends, and other spectators should stay a substantial distance (30 yards) from competitors during play. After play has started, parents may not coach "or advise" players. A player is subject to a two stroke penalty on the first offense and disqualification by tournament officials if the coaching continues. On course encouragement, support, applause, etc. is not considered coaching or advice; therefore, it is permissible.

<u>Coaches</u>: A coach may coach a player from tee to green. The two coaches is allowed to coach once play has begun that day for that team or player. **Penalty Structure**: 1st offence-Warning. 2nd offence Stroke penalty for player and loss of coaching privileges for the coach. 3rd offence-Disqualification of the player for the entire tournament.

PLEASE NOTE: If there is any doubt as to a rule or procedure, play a second ball in accordance with Rule 20.1 and get a ruling as soon as possible.

Return your <u>signed and attested</u> scorecard to the scoring area as soon as possible.

Contest Rules:

United States Golf Association (USGA) rules will govern all play except where local and/or UIL rules apply. Ignorance of the rules is no excuse for an infraction and may result in a player's disqualification.

Rules Committee:

A rules committee appointed by the tournament director will act upon all rulings. Any protests must be made in writing to the tournament director.

Dress Code:

Shirts with collars only (No T-shirts). Slacks or knee-length shorts (No Jeans or Jean shorts). Golf Shoes (soft spikes only) or tennis shoes only.

Special Notes:

(1) All Oak Hurst rules must be observed. Violation may result in a player's disqualification. In the event of inclement weather, less than 36 holes may constitute the tournament. The final decision will be made by the tournament director.

(2) There will be an optional coach's meeting at 5:30 p.m. on Sunday, for the Girls Tournament and Tuesday, at 5:30 for the Boys Tournament. Mr. Joseph Inman and Mr.

Darrell Chase will be present to answer any questions.
