Spectator/Parents Rules

- Must always stay on cart path.
- May not walk with players and must always maintain distance from all players/groups during play.
- Always prohibited from scoring areas.
- Never allowed to give players snacks/drinks/etc during play.
- Never allowed to coach or give advice to players during play.
- Never allowed shuttle players. (EXCEPTION: If play has been suspended during inclement weather, players may be shuttled to safety)
- SPECTATORS are allowed to assist players in locating a lost ball.

Gallery Carts

- Gallery carts for practice rounds and tournament play are limited.
- Gallery carts are available on a first come first served basis at \$40 per cart.
- The pro shop will open at 6:30am.

Practice Rounds

- Qualifiers may play only one practice round at Shadow Hills GC after their district tournament.
- Designated Team/Medalist Practice Round:
 - o Girls-Sunday April 14, 2025, at 12:00 Noon (Progressive Start)
 - o Boys-Tuesday, April 16, 2025, at 4:00 PM (Shotgun Start)
 - Tee times will be assigned for the designated Team/Medalist Practice Rounds
- Teams/Medalists are encouraged to take your one practice round prior to the designated Team/ Medalist Practice Round to alleviate congestion. Please cancel your assigned tee time on those designated days if you choose to practice ahead of time.
- Assigned tee times are subject to change until the designated practice day.
- All practice rounds and carts can be arranged through the pro shop.
- Practice round green fees and cart fees will be paid directly to Shadow Hills GC.
- Practice round green fees are \$40 per player.
- Carts are available during the practice round at \$10 per rider.
- Qualifiers only, play the practice round. Parents are not allowed to play with qualifiers.
- Balls will be provided on the range before the practice round. (open spots)
- Practice areas are not regulated, and open at 7:00am.
- Please present tax-exempt form on all payments made to Shadow Hills GC

- Kitchen will open at 7am, coffee will be available.
- Please present tax-exempt form on all payments made to Shadow Hills GC

Dress Regulations

School approved, proper golf attire required.

Disgualifications

- Any player disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct is eliminated from that round only. ٠
- Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as profane/vulgar and/or abusive language audible to others; carelessly and/or deliberately throwing clubs; verbalizing with intent of intimidation; or exhibiting behavior not in accordance with the spirit of fair play.

Lubbock SD Every Child Every Dav

- First consideration of penalty should be per USGA rules. If the golfer's actions warrant, penalty may be disgualification for the round or the entire tournament, to be determined by the tournament director.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or rules violations concerning contact with players will result in removal from the premises.

Electronic Equipment

- Range finders (all types such as GPS, watches, etc) are the only electronic equipment allowed.
- Range finders that measure distance only may be used. Range finders with functions in addition to distance measurement are illegal.
- Violation of rules regarding electronic equipment will result in:
 - First offense: Warning administered.
 - Second offense: Disqualification from the round.

Protests

- A protest can only be submitted by a player or the player's coach/school representative.
- A protest must be submitted prior to scores being designated as final by the tournament director.

Coaching Rule

- The coach may engage with player(s) from tee to green.
 - Once a player steps onto the green, no coaching is allowed until the entire group has completed the hole.
 - Two Coaches allowed per Team/Medalist

Penalty Structure

- First offense: Warning
- Second offense: A one stroke penalty and loss of coaching privileges.
- Third offense: Disqualification of the player for the entire tournament.
