## **Region 3 Regional Golf Championship**

This will be the pace of play guideline that we will use during the Region 3 Regional Golf Championship. There is a 40 second time allotment for each shot. This time starts as soon as it is your turn to play and will stop after you hit your shot.

#### **BREACH OF PACE OF PLAY RULE:**

- 1.) **First Offense: Warning** A rules/tournament official will warn all players in the group as to their position in relation to time and to other groups on the course.
- 2.) Second Offense: Placed on the Clock- a rules/tournament official will tell each player in the group that they are on the clock.
- 3.) **Third Offense: Penalty Accessed-** a rules/tournament official will penalize any player/players who don't comply with the 40 second time allotment. (2 strokes)
- 4.) **Fourth Offense**: Disqualification- any player/players who haven't complied with the 40 second time allotment will be disqualified for that days round.

# **SPECTATOR RULES**

Spectators must stay on cart path at all times. **EXCEPTION:** when watching play on or around the green spectators may walk up on the mounds that surround the green to watch. Spectators need to stay 30 yards from the players.

Spectators **MAY NOT** walk down the fairway with the players.

Spectators need to stay 30 yards from the players at all times.

Spectator May assist in searching for lost golf balls.

Spectators are **NOT** allowed to give players snacks or drinks during the stipulated round. **ONLY** the designated coach may give the players snacks or drinks.

Spectators **NOT** allowed in the scoring area at any time.

Spectators **MAY NOT** give any advice during play. **ONLY** the designated coach may give the player advice during a stipulated round. Any other communication could be deem advice. The player could be penalized 2 strokes for every breach or disqualified.

Spectators **MAY NOT** shuttle players at anytime. **EXCEPTION:** In the event of inclement weather or dangerous situation, spectators **MAY** transport players to safety.

### Violation/Penalties-

First Offense- Player/Coach/Spectator-warned.

**Second Offense**- Player given a general penalty (2) strokes. Spectator removed from course for the remainder of the day. Coach notified.

**Third Offense**- Player disqualified for that days round. Spectator removed from the competition for the remainder of the championship. Coach notified.
