Guidelines & Regulations

Spectator/Parents Rules

- Must always stay on cart path.
- May not walk with players and must always maintain distance from all players/groups during play.
- Always prohibited from scoring areas.
- Never allowed to give players snacks/drinks/etc during play.
- Never allowed to coach or give advice to players during play.
- Never allowed shuttle players. (EXCEPTION: If play has been suspended during inclement weather, players may be shuttled to safety)
- SPECTATORS are allowed to assist players in locating a lost ball.

Gallery Carts

- Gallery carts for practice rounds and tournament play are limited.
- Gallery carts are available on a first come first served basis at \$25 per cart.
- The pro shop will open at 6:45am.
- No private carts allowed at Lakeridge.

Practice Rounds

- Qualifiers may play only one practice round at Lakeridge CC after their district tournament.
- All practice rounds and carts can be arranged through the pro shop.
- Practice round green fees and cart fees will be paid directly to Lakeridge CC.
- Practice round green fees are \$75 per player, including cart.
- No Practice Rounds on Sunday before 2PM.
- Qualifiers only play the practice round. Parents are not allowed to play with qualifiers.
- Balls will be provided on the range before the practice round. (open spots)
- Practice areas are not regulated, and open at 6:45am..
- Please present tax-exempt form on all payments made to Lakeridge CC

Food & Beverage

- Kitchen will be open at 7am-2pm, coffee will be available.
- Player/Coach meals can be arranged with the club in advance.
- No food/drinks from outside restaurants will be allowed in the club.
- Please present tax-exempt form on all payments made to Lakeridge CC (students/school personnel only on tax exempt charges)

Parking

- Overflow parking available down Vicksburg Street.
- No trailer/RV parking available.

Regional Tournament Competition

- Round 1:
 - o Teams/Medalists will be ranked by district scores to set tee times.
 - o Teams 1-8 and Medalists 1-8 will begin play on the #1 tee.
 - o Teams 9-16 and Medalists 9-16 will begin play on the #10 tee.

- Round 2:
 - o Teams/Medalists will be ranked by round 1 scores to set tee times.
 - o Teams 1-8 and Medalists 1-8 will begin play on the #10 tee.
 - o Teams 9-16 and Medalists 9-16 will begin play on the #1 tee.

NOTE: In case of 2 medalists from the same school, those medalists will not be paired in the same group but will tee off from the same hole.

NOTE: Tee times and groupings WILL NOT be given out over the pro shop phone!

Dress Regulations

School approved, proper golf attire required.

Disqualifications

- Any player disqualified for unsportsmanlike conduct is eliminated from that round only.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct is defined as profane/vulgar and/or abusive language audible to others; carelessly and/or deliberately throwing clubs; verbalizing with intent of intimidation; or exhibiting behavior not in accordance with the spirit of fair play.
- First consideration of penalty should be per USGA rules. If the golfer's actions warrant, penalty may be disqualification for the round or the entire tournament, to be determined by the tournament director.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct or rules violations concerning contact with players will result in removal from the premises.

Electronic Equipment

- Range finders (all types such as GPS, watches, etc) are the only electronic equipment allowed.
- Range finders that measure distance only may be used. Range finders with functions in addition to distance measurement are illegal.
- Violation of rules regarding electronic equipment will result in:
 - o First offense: Warning administered.
 - Second offense: Disqualification from the round.

Protests

- A protest can only be submitted by a player or the player's coach/school representative.
- A protest must be submitted prior to scores being designated as final by the tournament director.

Coaching Rule

- The coach may engage with player(s) from tee to green.
 - Once a player steps onto the green, no coaching is allowed until the entire group has completed the hole.
 - o Two Coaches allowed per Team/Medalist

Penalty Structure

First offense: Warning

Second offense: A one stroke penalty and loss of coaching privileges.
 Third offense: Disqualification of the player for the entire tournament.

- •. 14 CLIB RULE IS IN EFFECT
- •. OUT OF BOUNDS Gas Meters (marked with white paint or not), white stakes, and the perimeter of the golf course.
- •. FREE RELIEF FROM ALL CONCRETE WATERWAYS #3, #6, #16
- •. HAZARDS WILL BE MARKED BY A RED OR YELLOW LINE.
- •. BALL WILL BE PLAYED DOWN FROM TEE TO GREEN
- •. WOOD STAKES OR CROSS TIES AROUND GREENS OR TEE BOXES WILL BE FREE RELIEF
- •. FREE RELIEF FROM ALL CART PATHS
- •. BAD WEATHER PLAY
 - A. If weather delays Round 1, Round 1 will be finished of Day 2
- B. If weather stops Day 2 Day 1 scores will be used to determine qualifiers for State

Note - Coaches will be allowed to transport players from 9 and 18 greens to the next tee box.
