

CLEAR CREEK (61) VS. BELTON (59)  
Conference AA-----Third Place

AUSTIN, March 4 — Bennie Lenox broke a free-throw record, then came back to can the decisive bucket just two seconds before the final buzzer as Clear Creek shaded Belton, 61-59, for third place in Conference AA of the Interscholastic League boys' basketball tournament here Friday afternoon.

Lenox set a Conference AA free-throw mark, hitting 16 of 17 charity attempts. The old record had been 14, established by Dana's Jimmy Cobb just last year.

He finished up with 36 points, netting 10 field goals including the big one.

Clear Creek held quarter leads of 20-18, 40-36 and 51-46.

Belton lost although it hit 52.6% of its shots to Clear Creek's 42%.
