

Conference B Championship.

AUSTIN, March 5 --- McAdoo's Eagles gunned down defending champion Midway of Henrietta, 58-42, to win the 1960 Conference B championship at the Interscholastic League boys' basketball tournament here Saturday afternoon.

George Scott of McAdoo, closing the tourney with a 14-point effort, shattered Conference B and all-tournament scoring records for individuals appearing in a three-game series. Scott finished with 88 points, topping the former Conference B mark of 79, set by Kermit Decker, Hutto, 1953. The 5-10 Scott's total also eclipsed the all-tourney record of 86 points in three games, established by Marcus Frieberger of Greenville in 1947.

McAdoo hit field goals at a 45.2 percentage clip to win a state title in its first trip to the tournament.

Scott had set a B single-game record Thursday, netting 43 in a ~~75-36~~ win over ~~Hutto~~.
