AUSTIN -- Houston Jesse Jones became the first team in state history to score over 100 points tonight with a smashing 106-71 victory over Kingsville in the Class AAAA action.

The victory moved Jones into the finals Saturday afternoon against Thomas Jefferson of Dallas.

Jones, led by Barry Lewis and Ronnie Arrow stormed to a 30-13 first quarter lead and ~~was~~ was never headed. A pair of free ~~shots~~ throws by reserve Paul Garza with 1:31 left in the game put Jones into a 100-65 lead.

The previous to urnament high was set by Sweeny in 1951 with 92 points. The Class AAAA record was 85 points set by Houston Milby in 1959.

The aggregate high score for one game was 165 set by Phillips and Webster in 1956 (Phillips 84, Webster 81), Jones and Kingsville totaled 177.

Lewis scored 29 and Arrow 27 for Jones.
