

Schools who have a diver with the NISCA All-American Qualification Degree of Difficulty (Girls – 13.0 DD total for Optionals; Boys – 13.2 DD total for Optionals) are allowed to appoint ONE individual per qualified diver to videotape for the purpose of All-American Diving qualifications submission. The individual designated as the videographer MUST be affiliated with the school at which the athlete attends (student or employee).

The school coach must request this videographer pass PRIOR TO the meet. Only qualified diving competitors will be allowed in the diving competition area. No spectators will be allowed on the diving deck. Film Passes can be picked up at school packet pick-up on Wednesday/Thursday OR upon arrival to the facility the days of the State Meet. Please note proper identification will be required for pick-up.

This form MUST be submitted by 11:59pm CST Tuesday, February 11th (4A) and 11:59pm CST Wednesday, February 19th (5A and 6A). Any forms submitted after the deadlines will not be accepted.
