DIGITAL WAIVERS

- ALL PERSONS represented on your registration must complete a digital waiver. This includes Athletes (cheer, mascot, flag runners), Alternates, and Adults (coaches, chaperones—all adults on reg). Waivers must be on file prior to the team's first scheduled practice. While the waivers are mobile-friendly, if you have trouble, we recommend utilizing a computer. If you need to adjust your REGISTRATION, please contact your Varsity Spirit State Director to do so.
- The link to the waiver is available in your My Varsity account under MY COMPETITION REGISTRATIONS.
- You are responsible for sharing your team's waiver link with everyone responsible for completing the waiver including parents/ guardians, athletes 18 years of age and older, and other adults registered with your team. The link to complete waivers should only be shared with athletes and adults associated with **your registration** as the link for your team is unique and pre-populated with your team's name, registration number, and UIL Spirit State Championships.
- You will be able to view the names of all team members who have completed their waivers and track the total waiver count. REMEMBER, you are expected to have the same number of waivers as people represented on your registration.

REDEMING TICKET / SPECTATOR WRISTBANDS

Upon arrival at the Fort Worth Convention Center, your QR code will be scanned and exchanged for a wristband for that day. Your wristband gives you access to both venues (Hall & Arena) ONLY for the day on which your Conference/Division is competing. If you plan on attending multiple days for different Conferences/Divisions, you will need to purchase additional tickets for those days or an all-session pass. Wristbands must be worn for admittance into both venues. All 5A DI and DII Qualifying Round ticket purchases include a ticket for both 5A Qualifying on January 17 and 5A State Championships January 18.

For those needing assistance in purchasing a digital ticket, please visit the ticket booth located on the HALL Side near the 11th street entrance. Tickets can be redeemed for wristbands at BOTH the Arena & Hall entrances. The Hall entrance will also have a Scan & Go Counters where tickets can be redeemed for wristbands.

TEAM DROP OFF

Drivers will drop teams at the Convention Center and then proceed to satellite parking. <u>Team Drop off is on Houston Street ONLY.</u> Look for designated pick-up/drop-off area and signage on Houston Street. Teams should be dropped off and picked up at the FWCC only.

Teams will enter through the **13**th **street entrance.** It is suggested that athletes report to **Team Holding area UPSTAIRS in the 2**ND **Floor Ballroom.** while the coach completes Team Check-In. While teams may shop at the merchandise shop, they will NOT be allowed to linger around or camp out in the concourse or venues. The lobby must remain clear, and security will require teams to move if you are camped out.

Additional bus parking and shuttle information is included at the end of this packet.

EVENT CHECK-IN:

A representative from each team must check-in to complete paperwork and receive team credentials. Check-In must be completed at least 30 minutes prior to the team's assigned WARM UP check-in time which can be found on the Performance Order. Event Check-In is in Room 103 AB (near 12th & Houston Street entrance). Teams are welcome to complete Check-In prior to competition day. Event Check-In will also be open on Wednesday.

NOTE: Due to the unique registration set-up for this event, the # WAIVERS EXPECTED may not match your actual registration. Please just make sure you have a completed waiver for every person associated with your registration.

CREDENTIALS

Team credentials will be in the Event Check-In packet. Shoe tags and wristbands must be worn at all times to enter the Practice Room. ALL athletes, including alternates, must wear the shoe tag ON THEIR SHOE. Non-participating athletes registered as "ADDITIONAL ATHLETES (OVER MAX)" will receive a wristband that provides access to the Team Holding Area, but NOT the Practice Room or backstage.

SCHEDULE, PRACTICE & MUSIC

PERFORMANCE ORDER:

Please refer to the <u>UIL Spirit website</u> for the most up-to-date schedule. The performance order link will be updated on the UIL website should any changes occur. Please print the order prior to arrival if you wish to have a paper copy.

The Performance Order contains VITAL information including specific designated Warm Up Check in and Performance times as well as general times when key information—like teams advancing to the State Championships Round—will be announced and posted.

WARM UP / PRACTICE AREAS:

Rooms at the FWCC are NOT available to be reserved for team practice on any day. Each team has a designated warm up time prior to performing on competition day. Designated times for each team to check in the warm-up area are located on the right-hand side of the Order of Performance. Please DO NOT be late for your warmup check in so that you have time for your **TEAM PHOTO** prior to taking the warmup mat. **PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE!**

Only team members and Coaches with practice room credentials may enter the practice area. Family members and spectators will not be admitted to the practice area. A high-quality sound system will be provided for teams with music on mp3.

EXPLANATION OF TIMES ON THE PERFORMANCE ORDER

Practice Check-In:

- Will be approximately **30 minutes prior** to your performance time.
- This is **not** your mat time. When you check in outside of the practice hall, you will be directed inside to the team holding area to take your **TEAM PHOTO**. Please be prepared for the photo.
- After the team photo, teams will be directed to the assigned practice area.
- If you miss your practice time, you are NOT guaranteed another opportunity to practice in the designated area.

Warm Up Time:

- This is your first practice rotation. You will have 7 minutes without music to warm up skills, stunts, stretch, etc.
- This station will have 3 strips of cheer floor

Mat Time:

- This is your second practice rotation. You will have 7 minutes to **utilize the FULL FLOOR with sound system** to prepare for your performance time.

Backstage/On Deck:

- After your second rotation you will proceed backstage.
- Coaches and alternates will be directed to proceed to **the music table** upon arriving backstage. All persons should remain in the appropriate area and should not create any distraction from the team performance.

PERFORMANCE MUSIC:

All performance music should be prepared by the team and played from a music playing device. Phones, iPads, and iPods are acceptable. **All coaches must bring their own DONGLE adaptor** to connect it to the aux chord attached to the sound systems provided in the practice room and in the performance area.

Please make sure the music is downloaded to your device. DO NOT attempt to stream or play from the "cloud" or a streaming site that requires internet for the music to play. Screen recordings of music or playing a file saved to the Notes app is NOT recommended. Test playing your music with AIRPLANE MODE on. CD's will NOT be accepted. You will be able to plug your device directly into the sound system to play your routine music. A coach or team representative MUST remain at the music table to push play and manage the music. Refer to Rules (Section III, page 8) for information regarding interruption of performances. Be sure to follow these steps below prior to your performance:



SCORESHEETS, ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINALISTS, & AWARDS

SCORE SHEETS:

Score sheets from the **Qualifying Round** will be available approximately 45 minutes after your team has performed and may be picked up at Event Information located in 103 AB. **State Championships Round score sheets** will be distributed following completion of the Awards Ceremony. Please make sure to pick up your score sheets prior to your departure. Only one coach per team should come to Event Information to pick up the team's score sheets. Comprehensive results will be posted on the UIL website following the completion of the State Championship.

OPPORTUNITY TO ADVANCE / ANNOUNCEMENT OF FINALIST:

When possible, we will post teams with the "Opportunity to Advance" in Band. This allows teams that will not advance travel flexibility. Teams advancing to the State Championship Round will also be posted in BAND and announced in each venue. Timing for these announcements is listed on the Performance Order. To ensure announcements are not missed, please make sure BAND notifications are turned ON. Emails communicating which teams will advance to the State Championship Round will not be sent. If leaving FWCC, be mindful of important timeline details such as these announcements.

Follow these steps to ensure you stay up to date on ALL event information:

Open the **BAND** app on your phone → Go into the **UIL group** → Click the **SETTINGS ICON** in the **BOTTOM RIGHT HAND CORNER** → **Toggle** the notification types pictured below to **ON** → Catch up on all the posts that you've missed so far

Teams advancing will be placed in the STATE CHAMPIONSHIP Order of Performance by random draw.

AWARDS / RECOGNITITION:


Awards will be presented following the completion of the State Championships Round in each division. Awards will be given as follows:

- "Best of Category" recognition plaques will be awarded to the top scoring team in each division for the three Game Day elements in the Qualifying Round: Band Chant, Crowd Leading, and Fight Song.
- Of those that advance to the State Championships, the top three teams will be awarded and designated as a 3rd place team, 2nd place with a runner-up silver trophy and 1st place with a championship gold trophy.
- Each team member of the top three teams and one school coach will be awarded an individual medal.

TEAM HOLDING AREA | Second Floor Ballroom

Teams are NOT allowed to camp out or linger in the first-floor lobby areas. When NOT practicing or competing, teams may gather in the Ballroom located on the SECOND Floor. The ballroom holding area should NOT be used to practice or fully run through routines: When not competing, teams can:

- Hang out in the Second Floor Ballroom with all their belongings.
- Watch from the spectator seating in the Arena (Exhibit Hall reserved for competing teams and spectators)
- Shop at the merchandise in the Exhibit Hall
- Look at action/team photos at the UEP photo kiosks
- Leave the facility and explore Fort Worth!

15 PASSENGER VANS:

- We encourage all buses and school vehicles to utilize Broadway Baptist Church for parking to accommodate more spectators to fill the garages closer to the FWCC. However, 15 passenger vans can park in the **Houston Street Garage** if vehicle is not taller than 7'6". Parking will only be allowed on the SOUTH WALLS (not on the ramps).
- 15 passenger vans CANNOT park in the Commerce Street Garage.

SHUTTLE INFORMATION FOR BUS DRIVERS:

The shuttle bus is for BUS DRIVERS ONLY. No teams will take the shuttle. Shuttles will be available **Thursday-Saturday** for BUS DRIVERS ONLY and will run between the satellite parking lot (see maps) and the FWCC.





CALHOUN STREET PARKING LOT

- Closest to the Convention Center, First Come First Serve
- Parking instructions from lot owner below
 - The address for the parking lot is 1075 Calhoun Street and it's within walking distance of everything downtown. There are no vehicles height restrictions on the lot. Parking location is shown on this <u>link</u>.
 - Anyone parking an oversized vehicle will need to use the payment information below. Reminder that
 each oversized vehicle will have to be paid individually as the transactions are tracked via License Plate.
 The Parking Fee is \$40 per 24 hours. (I.e. If you purchase at 2pm on Monday the 1st, your parking is paid
 for until 2pm on Tuesday the 2nd.)
 - Payment can be made by scanning the QR Code at the lot or using Park Mobile and using zone 690902. I would STRONGLY recommend payment be made once the vehicles are on site. Receipts will automatically be emailed to the customer after paid parking time is complete if they create and account. Receipts can also be found at this website https://www.parking-receipts.com/ once the transaction is complete. Since the buses may be leaving and coming back, they need to use the above information. The signs on the parking lot are designated for vehicles that are only being parked and left in the same parking spaces for the entirety of their payment.







Satellite Parking Shuttle Drop Off/Pick Up Location at Convention Center







DIRECTIONS FROM SATTELITE PARKING TO CONVENTION CENTER PICK UP




